

## TAKE HOME INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR CONTAINER OF NEWLY PLANTED SEEDS



1. Place your container of newly planted seeds outside where it will be exposed to the rain and snow (do not place under an eave).
2. When weather warms up (March?...April?) check your container. When the plants begin to germinate and emerge from the soil, take off the lid to prevent the seedlings from burnin up!
3. As the seedlings grow, prevent the pots from drying out. Watch over them and water as needed.
4. Transplant into the garden. There's no need to prick out the individual seedlings. Instead, plant the entire pre-vegetated mat or cut into smaller pieces.
5. Continue to watch over the newly planted seedlings while they take root in your garden.
